This year we will offer seven year-long residencies and two different part-time apprenticeships – one in the summer in Los Angeles and one that unites a cohort of apprentices from around the country via Zoom each week (September – May). Regardless of the program type, each participant will be matched with an experienced coach, attend our national apprenticeship training this summer in Kansas City, join a cohort of peers for reflection a support, and take the risk to start or continue a new ministry.

We would like to help you expose them to a calling they may not be aware they have. This retreat will be at Massenetta Springs Conference Center, Harrisonburg, VA. July 20 - 22, 2018. We are inviting youth who completed grade 7 through grade 9 to be a part of a gathering for the weekend.

We trust this will be a time for all our youth getting to know each other, learn about PC(USA), examining their part in Christ's commission, and just plain having fun as Christians. One initiative of this caucus in to create an environment that will help us identify young people who appear to be suited for church vocations. The Mid Atlantic Black Caucus want to help you mentor and encourage our youth to consider ordained ministry. We think it is not too early to start this process and feel now is the time.

Cost of the retreat is \$110.00 per person, (youth and/or adult.) This includes all that is needed for the weekend retreat, transportation not included.
